# **Kyoto University GSM SDGs Leadership Award 2024 Application Guidelines**

(Revised on July 9, 2024)

# 1) Purpose of the Award

The purpose of the Kyoto University GSM SDGs Leadership Award is to identify and cultivate SDG-related project and research activities promoted by graduate students and graduates at the Kyoto University GSM.

# 2) Outline

#### 2-1) Target Activities

SDG-related practical and research activities undertaken by students and graduates of the Graduate School of Management, Kyoto University (GSM) will be considered.

Both for-profit and non-profit activities are acceptable. Both individual and group applications are acceptable. Individual applicants must be students or graduates of GSM. In the case of group applications, the applicant representative must be a student or graduates of GSM, and may inculde non-GSM students and others beyond Kyoto University. Collaborative projects with other organizations are also acceptable.

Winners from the previous year or the year before the previous year cannot apply as a representative.

If multiple entries are submitted by the same entrant, only one prize will be awarded. (We will not prevent you from applying for multiple jobs)

#### 2-2) Application Categories

There are the following two application categories.

#### (A) SDGs Project Award

Target Activities: Projects related to the SDGs (Business, Educational Activities, etc.)

[Application Requirements]

• Graduate students or graduates of GSM must be the leader or in an equivalent role (co-leader, etc.) of the project concerned.

#### (B) SDGs Research Award

Target Activities: Research projects related to the SDGs.

[Application Requirements]

- Academic output must exist. Research in the conceptual stage is not eligible.
  - Academic outputs include papers, conference presentations, books, working papers, and reports on completion of GSM. When applying, PDF files of manuscripts of papers, abstracts of conference presentations, abstracts of books, etc. must be attached.
  - For current students, interim workshop reports can be submitted <u>if the supervisor of the student feels that the report is "of a high enough standard" to be considered for an award.</u>
     However, as a minimum requirement, it <u>must be in the form of an academic report.</u>
- The first author or co-authors of the academic output must be graduate students or graduates of GSM.

### 2-3) Special Awards and obligations

#### [Special Awards]

- 1. SDGs Project Award
  - Outstanding project(s) will be selected from among the entries to the "SDGs Project Category".
  - Up to 150,000 yen per project as a supplementary prize
- 2. SDGs Research Award
  - Outstanding research(es) will be selected from among the entries to the "SDGs Research Category".
  - o Up to 150,000 yen per project as a supplementary prize
- 3. SDGs Special Prize
  - Up to two outstanding activities across both categories will be selected.
  - Up to 150,000 yen per project as a supplementary prize
- \* If no applications are deemed reaching the standard of an Award mentioned above, no receipient may be named for it.
- \* The prize money will be transferred to the account of the individual applicant representative.

# [Obligations of Award Recipients]

- The selected recipients will be asked to attend the award ceremony (After the selection process, it is planned to be held in person/online from late October to early February 2024).
- The name, the titles of project/research activities, activity <u>summaries</u>, and <u>the amounts of the awards</u> of the recipients will be **announced on the web site** of GSM.

# [Obligations of ALL applicants]

• All applicants' names, titles of practical/research activities, and activity summaries will be archived at GSM, and used to apply for EQUIS, the international accreditation for MBAs.

# 3) How to apply

  will be formally completed.

### 4) Selection

#### (A) SDGs Project Award

The Selection Committee will conduct the 1st stage review (scheduled in Mid September 2024), and those who pass the first round will be asked to submit a video presentation (5-10 minutes) for the 2nd stage review (scheduled for Early October 2). Based on the submitted presentation videos, the Selection Committee will conduct the 2nd stage review and select the winners.

The selection results will be notified by e-mail to each applicant immediately after the decision is made. Please note that we will not be able to respond to the reasons for acceptance or rejection.

#### (B) SDGs Research Award

Based on the submitted "Application Form (Form 1)" and "Academic Output," the award recipients will be determined through a document review.

\* For both divisions, The selection results will be notified by e-mail to each applicant immediately after the decision is made. Please note that we will not be able to respond to the reasons for acceptance or rejection.

#### 4-1) Selection Process

#### ◆ **Application period** [Until 23:59, Thursday, October 31, 2024]

Submit documents according to the method specified in "3) How to Apply" of this application guideline.

# (A) SDGs Project Award

#### **♦1st stage review (document review)**

- (1) Selection by the Selection Committee (approximately 2 weeks after the end of the application)
- (2) Notification to Successful Applicants (Scheduled for late november, notification will be sent via email)

# **◆2nd stage review (video presentation)**

- (1) Video Presentation Submission (Scheduled for Late-November to early December, approximately 2 weeks)
  - Please record and submit your presentation video using Zoom.
  - In the video, share your screen to present your application content and highlight your strengths, within a duration of 5 to 10 minutes.
  - We will provide detailed instructions on how to submit the presentation video at a later date.

# (B) SDGs Research Award

#### **♦**document review

Based on the submitted "Application Form (Form 2)" and "Academic Outputs," the award recipients will be determined through a document review.

- (2) Selection by the Selection Committee (Scheduled for early-December, approximately 2 weeks)
- (3) Determination and Notification of Award Recipients (Scheduled for Mid-December, notification will be sent via email)

## **◆**After the award recipients have been determined

The award ceremony is scheduled to take place in Mid-February 2025.

#### 4-2) Selection Criteria

For each category, Awards will be presented for overall excellence based on the following

#### (A) SDGs Project Award

- 1. Does the project contribute to the SDGs (conformity with the purpose)
- 2. Is the project expected to have a social impact/achieve results (ripple effect)
- 3. Is the project expected to be sustainable in the future (sustainability)
- 4. Is the project unique and original, reflecting the applicant's unique viewpoints, etc. (Originality)
- 5. Relevance to what the applicant has learned at the Graduate School of Management, Kyoto University.

#### (B) SDGs Research Award

- 1. Does the research contribute to the SDGs (conformity with the purpose)
- 2. Is the research expected to have a social impact/achieve results (ripple effect)
- 3. Is the research unique and original, reflecting the applicant's unique viewpoints, etc. (Originality)
- 4. Relevance to what the applicant has learned at the Graduate School of Management, Kyoto University.

#### 4-3) Selection Committee

In the interest of fairness, selection committee members will be announced after the SDG Leadership Awards selection process has been concluded.

# 5) Handling of Personal Information, etc.

- Personal information sent to us at the time of application will not be used for any purpose other than the selection process for this award.
- If you are selected as a recipient, the applicants' name, the title of project/research activities, a summary of the activity, and the amount of the award will be announced on the web site of the Graduate School of Management, Kyoto University.
- All applicants' names, titles of practical/research activities, and activity summaries will be archived at
  the Graduate School of Management, Kyoto University, and used for EQUIS application, the
  international accreditation for MBAs.
